How to write a project report.

1. Sum up your project in the **Introduction** section of the report.
2. Describe how you were able to complete the project. A good report leaves no question unanswered. Readers will want to know exactly which steps were taken. You can call this your **Methods** section.
3. Explain the findings of your project in the **Results** section of your report. This is the body of the written piece, so it is where you can provide the details. **Drawings, photographs, tables and charts** can be included.
4. Close out the report with a **Conclusion** section. This is where you can give your feelings on the project overall.
